

## Rules — Design Section

1. Classes are open to all. An exhibitor may enter as many classes as desired, but entries are limited to one per class.
2. Advanced registration is required for all classes. Call Muriel Turner (703-713-0138; NuNuGlevum@cox.net) or Karen O'Mara (703-281-4334) before June 11, 2009. Exhibitor will be responsible for filling the required space, maintaining the exhibit in show condition and to provide a substitute if unable to participate. Each design must have been created and placed by one exhibitor.
3. Entries will be accepted Friday, June 26 from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m. and Saturday, June 27, 2009 from 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. and must remain in place until 4:00 pm Sunday, June 28, 2009 when they should be removed promptly.
4. **Lilium** **MUST** be the dominant feature of the design because this is part of the PLS show. All components may be exhibitor's choice except for the lilies. A 3" x 5" card listing all plant materials used must accompany each entry.
5. All classes will be staged within 30" x 30" space on 29" high tables covered with green plastic cloth. Exhibitors **MUST** provide a 30" x 40" FLAT BACKGROUND PANEL, **MUST** provide mechanics to hold background upright, and **MAY** use an underlay.
6. The National Garden Clubs Standard of System Judging will be used.

## Rules — Horticultural Section

- Classes are open to any grower of lilies.
- All lilies exhibited in competition must have been grown by the exhibitor. Exhibitors may make more than one entry in a class, provided that each is a different cultivar. Entries permitted in dual names, but no duplicate entries from the same garden.
- Only true lilies (genus *Lilium*) having scaly bulbs permitted. Entries to be free of obvious defects and/or disease. Specimens with abnormalities will be set aside and not judged. Anthers may be removed, but it is preferable to leave them on. A lily stem must have one bloom open to the typical shape for that particular variety to be eligible for judging.
- Entry cards and containers for specimens will be furnished by the Show Committee. In collections, each stem is shown in an individual container. Each entry must be correctly named, identified with an official entry card and placed in the proper class. Both sections of the entry card must be completed.
- Exhibits must be in place, ready for judging not later than 10:30 a.m. on Saturday 27 June and must remain in place until 4:00 p.m. on Sunday 28 June when they should be removed promptly. Entries not claimed by 4:30 p.m. will be disposed of by the Committee.
- Entries are the property of the exhibitor, and are not to be touched by anyone else except the Show Committee. Anthers and pollen may be removed only by the owner, or with the owners express permission.
- Doors will be closed during judging. Only Judges, Clerks, Runners, Tabulators, Chairman of Judges and Classification, and the Show Chairman may be present while the judging is in progress.
- At the close of the show, the exhibit room will be cleared before dismantling. Only exhibitors will be permitted in the showroom to remove exhibits.
- The following official NALS scale of points will be used in evaluating specimens entered in all sections except Section C.

##### Class

- Lilies grown in pots with no protection. Single pots.

#### SECTION H

##### Class

- All forced lilies or lilies grown with a substantial amount of protection. Single-stem or pot.

#### SECTION I

##### Class

- Single lily bloom of any named hybrid clone, named strain or species. (Limited to 3 entries per exhibitor.)
- Single lily bloom of an un-named hybrid seedling, grown from seed by the exhibitor. (Limited to 5 entries per exhibitor.)

#### SECTION J Novice Section

*A novice is someone who has never won a blue ribbon at a lily show.*

##### Class

- Single Lily stem. Exhibitor may enter as many stems as desired so long as each stem is of a different cultivar. A minimum of three blue ribbons are required to compete for the Novice Sweepstakes Award.
